Mumps, also called mammo-mas, is a viral disease that affects the salivary glands, an important part of the body's immune system. Mumps causes swelling of the salivary glands (known as parotitis). Mumps can also affect the jaw, testicles, breasts, pancreas, and ovaries. Serious complications from mumps include aseptic meningitis, and encephalitis. About 20 to 50 percent of those infected with mumps develop encephalitis. About 90 percent of the time the cause of mumps is an infection with the mumps virus. The mumps virus can remain in the body for a long time, usually causing symptoms for about two weeks after the infection has been contracted. Mumps is a common childhood disease that can occur when a person is exposed to the virus. Mumps is usually characterized by a headache and fever, followed by swelling of one or both parotid glands (salivary glands). Additional symptoms include muscle pain, difficulty swallowing, fatigue, loss of appetite, and pain around the eyes. About 10 percent of cases of mumps also lead to the formation of nodules (small lumps) in the salivary glands. About 5 to 15 percent of cases are severe and can cause inflammation of the brain. Symptoms of brain inflammation include headache, weakness, and fever. Symptoms and signs of mumps usually last about two weeks. For some people, mumps can be caused by a reactivation of an infection. Mumps is most often spread from person to person through close contact. People who have had mumps have about a 30 to 50 percent chance of passing the infection to someone else. Another way to spread mumps is from an infected person to a healthy person through droplets of saliva that land in the mouth, nose, or on the face. Medical care for mumps is aimed at making the person well, not at curing the mumps. The treatment is similar for anyone who has the disease. Initially, one or both parotid glands may swell. A person with mumps is also more likely to develop swelling in the jaw and neck. Mumps can also cause pain, tenderness, and swelling of the testicles in 82157476af
